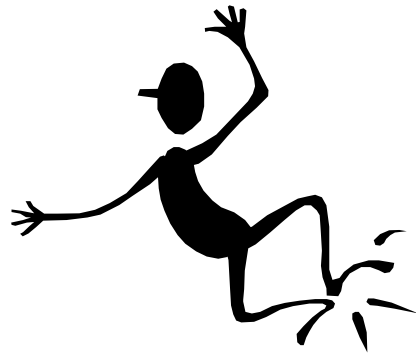
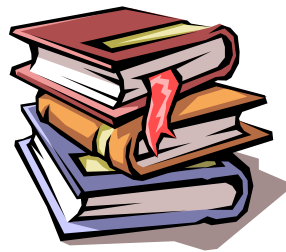

PEAK READER PUMPKIN PROGRAM 2007 DETAILS

- Program runs for three weeks, anytime after **September 10th**
- School Coordinator must request tickets by **Thursday October 11th**
- Students may pick up their pumpkins Friday through Sunday or by special arrangement for Field Trip
- Passes expire **October 31st**
- Expiration dates will not be extended for any reason

4-6	150	250	350

- A **reading chart** and a **“rules & guidelines” sheet** must be signed for each student
- Schools are responsible to distribute the passes to the students
- Tickets will not be replaced if lost, stolen, or destroyed
- Schools may apply the program to fit their own reading program

PEAK READER RULES & GUIDELINES Parent & Student Copy

1. **Safety Issue:** For the safety of participating students, we require at least one adult supervisor for every three children that attend the park. No exceptions. We encourage all parents to make the responsible decision to come to the park with their children or to have them accompanied by another adult.
2. Students may qualify as a PEAK READER if they are in Kindergarten through 6th grade and meet the following extracurricular reading requirements (**reading for school assignments does not apply**):

Reading Requirements:

GRADE(S)	Small Pumpkin	Medium Pumpkin	Large Pumpkin
K-1	100	200	300
2-3	125	225	325
4-6	150	250	350

3. Students who wish to qualify as PEAK READERS must read the required number of pages over a three week period, anytime between **September 10, and October 5, 2007**. The signed reading chart and a signed copy of this sheet must be turned in to the teacher for each student by **October 8, 2007**.
4. Each student who reads the required number of pages will receive ONE FREE PUMPKIN (either small, medium, or large) from the Cooperstown Funpark. Pumpkins may be picked up **Friday through Sunday** beginning October 19, 2007. All Peak Reader Passes expire on **October 31, 2007** regardless of circumstance. The expiration date will not be extended for any reason. No exceptions will be made to this policy due to the large volume of tickets.
5. It is the responsibility of each school, not the Cooperstown Funpark, to ensure the proper distribution of all Peak Reader Pumpkin Passes. Students are responsible to pick up their individual pass from the school, not Cooperstown Funpark, at the appointed time.
6. Peak Reader Passes are for qualified students only and may not be transferred or exchanged. **Tickets will not be replaced** if lost, stolen, or destroyed.

PEAK READER RULES & GUIDELINES School Coordinator & Teacher Copy

1. **Ethical Issue:** We have had some individuals in years past abuse the Peak Reader Program by submitting false names and accumulating tickets for themselves. We at Cooperstown Funpark enjoy being a part of the program and do not want to eliminate it because of a few individuals. We ask the school coordinator, teachers, and parents to help us oversee the proper distribution of tickets. Any unearned tickets must be returned to Cooperstown Funpark.
2. **Safety Issue:** For the safety of participating students, we require at least one adult supervisor for every three children that attend the park. No exceptions. We encourage all parents to make the responsible decision to come to the park with their children or to have them accompanied by another adult.
3. Students may qualify as a PEAK READER if they are in Kindergarten through 6th grade and meet the following extracurricular reading requirements (**reading for school assignments does not apply**):

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4. Each student who reads the required number of pages will receive ONE FREE PUMPKIN (either small, medium, or large) from the Cooperstown Funpark. Pumpkins may be picked up **Friday through Sunday** beginning October 19, 2007. All Peak Reader Passes expire on **October 31, 2007** regardless of circumstance. The expiration date will not be extended for any reason. No exceptions will be made to this policy due to the large volume of tickets.
5. The signed reading chart and a copy of the "Rules & Guidelines" sheet must be turned in to the teacher for each student by **October 8, 2007**. The school's coordinator must request tickets from Cooperstown Funpark before **October 11, 2007** by filling out the "Ticket Request Form." For each ticket requested, the coordinator must also turn in the "Rules & Guidelines sheet signed by the student's parent or guardian.
6. It is the responsibility of each school, not Cooperstown Funpark, to ensure the proper distribution of all Peak Reader Passes. Students are responsible to pick up their individual pass from the school, not Cooperstown Funpark, at the appointed time.
7. Peak Reader Passes are for qualified students only and may not be transferred or exchanged. **Tickets will not be replaced** if lost, stolen, or destroyed.
8. Schools may submit a written proposal to Cooperstown Funpark outlining the details of their own "reading program." If approved, this program may be used in place of the requirements proposed by Cooperstown Funpark to qualify students as PEAK READERS.
